Mr. Winfield Boerckel, “Win” served as CancerCare’s Long Island Director of Social Service and was charged with directing clinical services delivered to Long Island residents dealing with a diagnosis of cancer or providing care to a loved one with cancer. In addition, he coordinated CancerCare’s National Lung Cancer Program, and maintained clinical responsibility for developing and implementing supportive activities and systems for lung cancer patients and their caregivers; he also facilitated virtual support groups for cancer caregivers and lung cancer patients on Long Island.

Mr. Boerckel served on the professional advisory boards for the websites: lungcancer.org, and the ASCO website, www.cancer.net. In addition, he had served on the editorial advisory board of CURE Magazine. He was also CancerCare’s delegate to the Global Lung Cancer Coalition, and, participated as Treasurer on that organization’s Steering Committee. He continues to work with that organization in an advisory capacity.. He is a recipient of the Lung Cancer Alliance’s first annual Lung Cancer Support Group Award. He participated in the American Cancer Society’s National Lung Cancer Roundtable as a member of the Shared Decision Making Task Group, and has presented on lung cancer patient psychosocial needs at workshops both in the United States and Europe.

Mr. Boerckel has also participated as a speaker for numerous CancerCare Connect® Education Workshops on such subjects as *Lung Cancer: Building Vital Networks & Support Systems*, *New Treatment Options for Advanced Lung Cancer*, *Managing the Side Effects of Lung Cancer Treatment*, *Living With Lung Cancer: Navigating Your Healthcare Team*, *Resources and Support Systems*, *Coping with the Diagnosis of Lung Cancer: Moving from Isolation to Connectivity*, and *The Nuts and Bolts of Starting A Lung Cancer Support Group*.
